This expectation is communicated at the beginning of our business relationships and reinforced regularly.

We reserve the right to terminate our relationships with individuals and organizations acting on our behalf if they fail to comply with our policy.



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This statement is issued in compliance with section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and serves as our slavery and human trafficking statement for the current financial year.
